### ***Cremation***

*With an estimated completion date of December 2012, all Holy Family Parishioners will have the option to inurn loved ones in this permanent memorial on our parish grounds.*

*Although cremation is now permitted by the Church, it is the Church's preference that cremation take place after the funeral services. The Church urges that the body of the deceased be present for the funeral rites, since the presence of the human body better expresses the values which the Church affirms in those rites. If necessity dictates that cremation takes place prior to the Church service, the services should be scheduled at a time to allow for the cremated remains to be present for the funeral liturgy.*

*The final disposition of the cremains is important, say the instruction: "The cremated remains should be buried in a grave or entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium. The practice of scattering cremated remains on the sea, from the air, or on the ground, or keeping cremated remains in the home of a relative or friend of the deceased are not the reverent disposition that the Church requires." The instructions also state that, if at all possible, the place of entombment should be marked with a plaque or stone memorializing the deceased.*
