### Letter from Father

17 November 2024 Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time On Giving Thanks and The Theology of Thanksgiving

Greetings,

No need to panic, Thanksgiving isn't this Thursday. Next week just has a lot going on, liturgically speaking, and so I need to write my Thanksgiving reflection a week ahead of time, which is apropos to giving thanks.

One of my most beloved candidates for sainthood in Blessed Solanus Casey. Fr. Casey was a Capuchin Franciscan priest from Detroit who humbly served the people of that city by greeting them at the door of the friary and seeing to their needs. Fr Casey was known for his sage advice and caring demeanor for people from every walk of life. One of the great pieces of advice that he gave to many people over the years was this, "Thank God ahead of time".

What does it mean to thank God ahead of time? It is the usual human habit to say thanks for anything after a service has been rendered or a gift given. This is normal to the transactional nature of human society; "I give you something, you thank me for it" and vice versa. But how often do we think about not just what God has given us already, but for what He might say, "No"?

I am reminded of a reflection of the things we ask of God and why He says, "No" so often.

I asked God to take away my bad habit. God said, "No. It is not for me to take away but for you to give it up". I asked God to heal my handicapped son. God said "No. His spirit is whole his body is only temporary". I asked God to give me patience but God said "No. Patience is a by-product of tribulations. It isn't granted but learned". I asked God to give me happiness but God said "No. I give you blessings, happiness is up to you".

I asked God to spare me pain but God said "No. Suffering draws you apart from worldly cares and brings you closer to me". I asked God to make my spirit grow but God said "No. You must grow on your own but I will prune you and make you fruitful". I asked God for all things that I might enjoy life but God said "No. I will give you life so you may enjoy all things".

I asked God to help me love others as He has loved me. God said "Ah, now you have the idea. The day is yours don't throw it away".

If we are truly people of Faith, seeking God's guidance and wisdom, we are thankful for the times that seem unfair or difficult or inconvenient. He wouldn't let us experience these things for naught, but that we might learn and grow by living them. How tragic if we only gave praise to God when things are going well for us.
