





Letter from Father

11 May 2025 4th Sunday of Easter Habemus Papam!

Greetings,

I usually write my weekly letter on Thursday so that I can comment on current events if necessary. I am writing this on Thursday morning, waiting with great anticipation, to see who our new Pope will be. I came to the realization that, during the same period of waiting for the previous three popes, I have been at school. It was a with great excitement that I burst into the middle school classroom and announced that white smoke was coming from the chimney at the Sistine Chapel. I was so moved to see the excitement that our students had for the news, even those who do not share our Catholic Faith.


