
















### **Changing Sides Abby Johnson Story**

### Letter from Father

#### Greetings,

As the Easter season progresses, we have a joyful day of Sacraments at Holy Family this Sunday. After Mass, I will baptize Gianna Catherine Dagelen, the newborn daughter of Evan and Nicole. It is what will happen during the Mass that is kinda special. You'll actually get a preview of our celebration of Confirmation and First Eucharist for our young people when we celebrate the Confirmation and First Eucharist for Gabriel Scheel, the youngest son of Michael and Tonya.

About twelve years ago, Gabe had a near-drowning accident that left him with profound brain trauma and serious physical challenges. Because of these issues, Gabe has not been afforded the opportunity to receive remaining Sacraments of Initiation when it was time for him to do so. The Holy Family Parish community has the honor of providing these Sacraments to Gabe and we rejoice with the whole of Holy Mother church as he completes his initiation into the Faith.

The usual questions of how someone like Gabe is able to participate in the Sacraments are natural. The beauty of these Sacraments is that the recipient need only express some understanding of what it is they are receiving, even if that person is unable to speak that expression. This can be as simple as a change in demeanor in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament or even an expression of joy when they enter a church for Mass. Shortly before his accident, Gabe told his mother that he felt like God was calling him to be an angel for her and his family. This was a remarkable sense of the Universal Call to Holiness to which every baptized person is called. Gabe said "angel" when, were he a little older at the time, he might have said "saint". It is enough, even if he is unable to say so, that Gabe has expressed a desire to serve God and live a holy life, a life which must include the Sacraments.

This might be a new experience for some of you. I look at this day as a wonderful example of God calling all of His children to the Light of Life. St. Therese of Lisieux made the following observation which I think perfectly sums up this day. She said, "The splendor of the rose and the whiteness of the lily do not rob the little violet of its scent nor the daisy of its simple charm. If every tiny flower wanted to be a rose, spring would lose its love-liness."

We celebrate this day of joy with Gabe, his parents and brothers, and the whole Church Herself and give thanks to God for the opportunity to be real witnesses to His Love and Mercy throughout the world.


