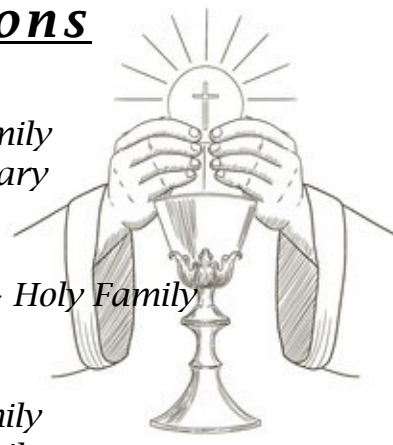

Themes for the Fourth Sunday of Easter.

Jesus as the Good Shepherd: Jesus calls Himself the Good Shepherd who knows His sheep and lays down His life for them. This image shows His deep care and willingness to sacrifice.

Repentance and Baptism: In Acts, Peter calls for repentance and baptism in the name of Jesus. This theme emphasizes turning away from sin and beginning a new life in Christ.

Following Christ's Example: Peter's letter urges us to follow Christ's example of suffering patiently. This teaches us to endure hardships with trust in God.

Hearing God's Voice: Jesus says His sheep hear His voice and follow Him. This highlights the importance of listening to Jesus and discerning His guidance in our lives.

New Life in Christ: Peter speaks of dying to sin and living for righteousness. This theme stresses the new life we receive through Christ's sacrifice and resurrection.

Conversion and Salvation: Acts recounts the conversion of many who hear Peter's message. This shows the power of the Gospel to change hearts and bring salvation.

Today reminds us of Jesus' care and guidance as our Shepherd. We are called to listen to His voice, follow Him, and live out our faith daily.

1. Born in Siena, Italy in 1347. She was born on the Solemnity of the Annunciation of Jesus (March 25th).
2. Said to have had the first visions of Jesus when she was just a child. Her experiences as a mystic continued throughout her life.

Greetings,

There is a scene in a movie in which a young man is being introduced to his girlfriend's parents. They are understandably concerned because the young man has a large tattoo across his neck that reads, "No Ragrets". The parents begin to question him and the dad asks him about the tattoo. The young man says, "It's my credo" and the dad says, "So, not one regret huh?" and he responds, "Nope, not one" and the father then forbids his daughter from going out with him. Rightly so.

This last week, a friend asked me if there was something that I wished I had done in my twenties. My first response was to the practical. I said that I wished I had stayed in the Army longer. I wished that I had been more cognizant of the world around me, not just my own little sphere of reality. On reflection, I said that I wished I had the wisdom and knowledge I have now back then and, finally, I wished that I hadn't been so self-centered and more attuned to the needs of those around me.

I can honestly say that I have a few regrets, not many serious ones but some smaller ones where I wish I had become better as a human being. I am able to say this because I learned at some point in my young adulthood that a mistake is only truly tragic if one does not learn from it. If one dwells on one's mistakes and either gives up or loses hope, the mistake is permanent. However, if I can look at my mistakes with a bit of objectivity and act on them to improve, regret is lost to hope.

This is the beauty of our Church. As a fallen and sinful race, we are given to sin and error, even though we are made in the image and likeness of our Creator. We, of all of the animals in Creation, are capable of reflecting on our actions and appreciating the gravity of what we do. And because we often choose the wrong, even having reflected on the wrongness of what we are doing, God has given us, in His infinite Love and Mercy, a means of being reconciled to Him. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is our correction for error. It is so simple and yet, so difficult, to believe that God will look past our willfulness and pride and call us back. And He does it every time. The remedy He offers is the contrition we show and the penance He asks of us. This penance is not meant to be a punishment but, instead, a curative measure for us to recognize our sinfulness and to show our desire to be reunited with the God who loves us.

Sin is indeed regretful but only truly and permanently regretful if we fail to ask for forgiveness. If we learn from our sin and commit to doing better, we become stronger in Faith and more secure in Hope.

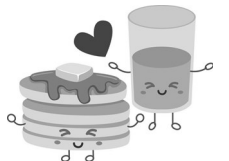
